Welcome to the Parents and Families of Barrington, Lawnside, and Haddon Heights,

My name is Anastasia Butterick, and I am the Assistant Director and Producer for the H.H. Junior High Musical. Additionally, our director is April Lindley. This year, our musical is Legally Blonde, Jr, and our performance dates are May 30th (7pm) and 31st (3pm) in the High School auditorium.

We are very excited for this year's production because we are opening up the program to Haddon Heights Junior High School (grades 6-8), Woodland Middle School (grades 7-8), and Lawnside Public School (grades 7-8) middle school students who do not have a program already instilled in their school.

Due to this program being offered to middle school students from multiple schools, most of our communication is set up through Remind and Google Classroom. If your child is interested in being involved in Legally Blonde, Jr., please follow these next steps to register them:

This calendar will become active on Friday, February 21st, 2020 @ 6:00 PM. This should be filled out as soon as possible or at the latest by Friday, March 27th, 2020 @ 11:59 PM. This will be needed for your child to audition. This form is also available on Google Classroom.

This form will become active on Friday, February 21st, 2020 @ 6:00 PM. This should be filled out as soon as possible or at the latest by Friday, March 27th, 2020 @ 11:59 PM. This will be needed in order for your child to audition. This form is also available on Google Classroom.
4. The show has a **maximum capacity of fifty (50) students**. So it is **imperative** that you complete these steps **as soon as possible** in order for your student to take part in the program. Please note that after completing the form, **you will receive an email confirming that your submission has been submitted**. Please look for this email. If you do not receive one, there may have been a problem with your submission and you will need to fill out the form again.
5. If the capacity is already filled, you will get a message saying that the show is full. From here, you should fill out the “**Waitlist - Interest/Cast Contact Information Form**.” The link is attached here.

We will take students from this waitlist, first come first served should a spot open. This link is also available on Google Classroom.

In doing the above steps, your child will be set-up to audition for the Junior High Musical. Auditions will be taking place on **Monday, April 6th from 3:30 - 6:00 pm in the high school auditorium**. Your student will be needed for this entire time for vocal and reading auditions. To prepare for these auditions, all audition materials will be posted on Google Classroom under “Classwork” and then “Audition Materials.” Your student should **prepare ONE (1) reading and ONE (1) song selection** to perform at auditions.

Once all auditions have been completed, a callback list will be posted on Google Classroom. Any students who are on this list will need to return back on **Wednesday, April 8th from 3:30-6:00 pm in the high school auditorium**. If your student’s name is not listed on the callback list, they do not need to come back to the school for callbacks. **Please note that ALL students who audition will be a part of the show.**
